

## Welcome to the Sports Field at Lower Beeding.

The village hall and sports field are owned and maintained by the Lower Beeding Association (registered charity 267433) for the benefit and enjoyment of all parishioners.



### Bar

The Village Hall Bar is usually open before, during and after each cricket match. It stocks a range of ales, cider, lager and wines at below pub prices. During the summer draught beer and cider is ordinarily available. Where possible this is sourced locally, typically from Kissinggate (Lower Beeding), Firebird (Rudgwick) and Silly Moo (Cowfold). A variety of snacks and chocolate bars can usually be found on sale too. The bar is card only.

### Facilities

There is plenty of on-site parking on the recently resurfaced tarmac area. For large events we can open the gates to allow parking on the football pitch. Under no circumstances should you park on the verges at the entrance to the car park, nor on Leechpond Hill (B2110).

The Hall has two changing rooms, both with showers. Please make every effort to leave these as you would expect to find them.
